Interpreting Styles

Consecutive Interpreting: This is our standard and most frequently requested interpreting service. A speaker verbally conveys two or three sentences followed by a pause, during which the interpreter repeats the message in the target language for the listener.

Simultaneous Interpreting: For larger conferences, workshops, and sales and businesses meetings, a minimum of two interpreters transmit messages into the target language in real time, alternating in 20-minute intervals. This interpreting style usually requires interpreting equipment—sound booths, headsets, receivers, etc.—which we can rent for your event.

Whisper Interpreting: This follows the same principle as simultaneous interpreting. However, instead of sitting in soundproof booths with microphones, interpreters sit next to or near the listener and transmits messages in a soft voice directly into the listener's ear.
